Starting with the same story you used in Assignment 9 (Single Frame Story) create a multi-frame story using 3 frames. You may approach this in a number of different ways:

1. Beginning - Middle - End of entire story
2. A single event/episode, portrayed in detail (in other words, beginning - middle - end of a single event in the story)
3. Multiple views of a single scene
4. Other??

You may start with the ideas/scene/characters used in your single-frame story, or try another approach. Either way, consider carefully the feedback/discussion we had in class to improve your storytelling.

NOTE: Do not re-use your actual single frame piece as part of this multi-frame assignment. Instead, refine and improve your idea, or try a different approach if you want.

Specifications:

Use only geometric shapes: circle, square, triangle, etc. NO freehand/freeform shapes.

Size of each frame: 8" x 8"

-OR-

you may vary the number and width of frames. The TOTAL width for all frames must add up to 24" (8" + 8" + 8")

Number each frame *on the back*.

Solid colors only. No textures or shading.

-> Turn in BOTH your original one-frame story and this new multi-frame story to be graded.
